On the authority record the standardized form is the key element for which the record was made, so it is also called the **heading**



#### Introduction


The Semantic Name Authority Repository Cymru (SNARC) was established in order to provide a central hub for name authority records relating to Wales and in the Welsh language. The authority records related to people, places or social constructs such as organisations or businesses. The database also includes all the additional data needed to describe these things, such as occupations, places of education, language and nationality. Based on Wikidata<sup>22</sup>, but using a simplified and customized ontology, the data is presented as Linked Open Data and this makes it easier for us to define relationships between entities in our collections. All the data is bilingual and available on an Open Licence. The dataset can be explored using the search box on this page, the links below or using the API <sup>22</sup> or Query Service<sup>22</sup>. Our goal is to grow the dataset using data from Wikidata and other sources, and data curated by GLAM professionals around the word.





### Mapping Properties to Wikidata

Some tools assume properties with special meanings under certain identifiers. Here, you can map a property on your Wikibase instance to a property on Wikidata. E.g. if a tool needs instanceOf (P31 on Wikidata) but the instanceOf property is P4 on your Wikibase you can create a mapping between them.
